CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to class start time!
Talking in class will not be tolerated.
No mobile phones or computer games allowed in the classroom.

UNIFORM

Jazz - black **soft soled** jazz shoes, dance gear, hair pulled back.

Jazz Teens - black jazz sneakers & cabaret shoes, dance gear, hair pulled back.

Modern Jazz Exam - black soft soled jazz shoes, coloured leotard, flesh fishnet tights, black 3/4 tights, hair in bun.

Tap - black tap shoes, dance gear, hair pulled back.

Tap Exam - black tap shoes, flesh fishnet tights, plain coloured leotard and matching circular skirt, hair in bun.

Acrobatics

Firm fitting flexible clothing - clean bare feet

Classical - leotard (for colours - see below), pink tights, ballet shoes with sandling (ribbons) from Grade 1 onwards, crossover, hair pulled back in bun.

PrePrimary & Primary-rose pink, Grade 1,2,3-blue, Grade 4,5,6-purple.

Grade 5 & 6- also require character shoes and character skirt.

2nd hand uniform stall held on 1st Saturday of every month.

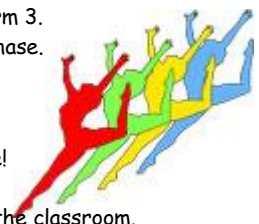
EXAMS

Students follow the CSTD exam syllabus.

Exams are taken in Classical, Modern Jazz, Contemporary and Tap.
Uniform as above.

EXAM fees must be paid prior to registration.

Students are expected to practice in their own time prior to exams and not miss classes close to exam time.
Parents are required to provide lunch and/or morning/afternoon tea for the examiner and assist with preparation for exam day.



CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

ACROBATICS

These classes are available for all skill levels.
Students learn a variety of acrobatic techniques such as: cartwheels, handstands, tumbling, flipping, trampolining and partner work.
Students welcome from 5 years of age.

CLASSICAL BALLET

Classical is a traditional, formal style of ballet known for its aesthetics and strict, rigorous technique (such as pointe work, turn-out of the legs, and high extensions), and graceful, flowing, and precise movements. Classes follow the CSTD syllabus and begin at Pre Ballet and work through Primary, Grades 1-6 and Majors. Students sit regular exams. Students welcome from 5 yrs.

CONTEMPORARY

Contemporary dance is the exploration of the total movement potential of the body. It is not bound by set standards as defined by styles such as ballet or Jazz dance. Classes follow the Jason Winter's CSTD syllabus and begin with a Foundation Grade and continue through the grades.

S.H.A.K.E. students sit yearly exams. Students welcome from 10 yrs.

JAZZ

The Term "Jazz" encompasses a number of dance styles, but generally refers to movements performed to popular music, At S.H.A.K.E. the open jazz classes vary in style from funk to cabaret and hip hop to lyrical. We learn basics like kicks, jumps and turns. We have classes for all ages and have had an ongoing Adult class for the past 15 years. A great way to keep fit and have fun!
Students welcome from 3 years of age (to 60 years).

MODERN JAZZ

Modern Jazz is basically the same as Jazz but follows a set syllabus designed by the CSTD. Students begin at the Pre Modern and Junior Levels and work through to Grades 1 -8.

S.H.A.K.E. students sit yearly exams. Students welcome from 5 yrs.

THEATRICAL/PERFORMING ARTS

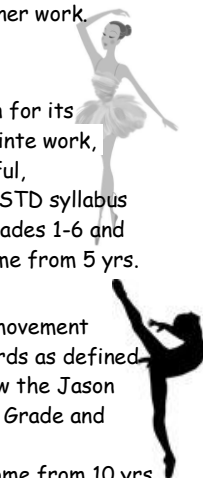
BRAND NEW to S.H.A.K.E! These classes incorporate singing, dancing and acting to create a true triple threat in the industry. Students begin at the Pre Level and continue through the grades. Students sit regular exams. Students welcome from 5 yrs.

TAP

Tap dance is a form of dance characterized by using the sound of one's tap shoes hitting the floor as a percussive instrument. As such, it is also commonly considered to be a form of music.

At S.H.A.K.E. the classes follow the CSTD syllabus but also incorporate an open element. It is not compulsory for the students to sit exams, but exam work is taught in the classes.

Students welcome from 5 years of age.
